REGULATIONS BAD GASTEIN CLASSICS

Online registration:

Registration takes place online via the following website: [Link to timing page](#)

Online registration is possible until Wednesday, 16.12.2026, 11.59 pm via the official website

Late registrations:

Late entries are possible from 17.12.2026 directly at the Race Office until 2 hours before the start of the race.

Start numbers & issue:

Start numbers will be issued on presentation of the deposit slip at the Race Office. Please note that race numbers can only be collected in person!

Distances: 15 km or 30 km

Technique: Classic (FIS ICR: 343.8)

Entry fee:

€ 69,- Early bird (until 30.9.2026)

€ 79,- Normal price (1.10.-10.12.2026)

€ 89,- late registration (from 17.12.2026)

Included in the entry fee*:

- Drink
- Catering
- Free toll access on the Gastein Alpine Road during the weekend
- Medical care during the race
- Goodie bag
- Race number
- Timekeeping
- Finisher medal
- Certificate to print out yourself
- Clothes bag

**The organiser reserves the right to adjust the offer at any time.*

Liability:

Participation is at your own risk. The organiser accepts no liability for damage to property or personal injury. In particular, the organiser is not liable for negligent or grossly negligent behaviour.

All participants are obliged to sign the disclaimer for the Bad Gastein Classics and to present it at the start number collection.

Refund:

Should the participant not start at the Bad Gastein Classics for any reason, no refund of the entry fee will be made. If the event cannot be held or can only be held in part due to force majeure, sovereign orders or other reasons beyond the control of the organiser, there is no right to a refund of the entry fee.

Changes:

The organiser reserves the right to make changes to the route, the organisational procedure and other programme points until further notice. In case of changes there is no right to a refund of the entry fee.

Rescue service & safety:

Final runners and the rescue service are expressly permitted to remove participants from the race who are in weak condition or show other signs of insufficient condition.

Medical care and ambulance service:

Teams of the Red Cross Gastein and Mountain Rescue Bad Gastein.

Timekeeping:

The timing will be provided by Ovento Timing using transponders. All participants are required to carry the transponder provided to them throughout the race. Participants who do not carry a transponder during the race will not receive an official result.

Transponder loss:

In the event of non-return or loss of the transponder, the respective participant is obliged to reimburse the organiser for the costs in this respect, which are prescribed to the organiser by the timekeeper, after requests within 14 days.

Start groups:

- Elite (allocation reserved to the organizer)
- Start Group 1 (top 10 female/male 15 km + top 15 female/male 30 km Gastein Classic 2025
 - o Other runners only upon prior separate request to the organizer (by e-mail to gastein.classics@gastein.com) with proof of an active FIS code or proof of corresponding placements. Requests for pre-ranking into the 1st start group must be submitted by 10.12.2026, 11.59 pm at the latest when online registration closes. Later requests will not be considered.
- Start group 2: Ambitious runners
- Start group 3: Pleasure runners

Start group 2 or 3 can be selected independently at the start, depending on your ambitions.

Ski deposit in start area:

The start area is open 30 min before the start for ski deposit.

Finish time:

4 pm

Fluorine wax ban:

In accordance with FIS-ICR: 222.8, the use of fluorine wax is prohibited. The organiser will carry out random checks.

Clothes drop-off and pick-up:

Clothes can be handed in 1h before the start in the designated area with a clothes bag marked with the respective start number. The dropped off clothes can be collected from the clothes collection area in the finish area until 30 min after the finish.

If there are less than 3 starters in an age group, this age group will be merged with the next age group according to the race regulations.

Eligibility:

For participation in the races over the 30 km distance Classic the minimum age is 16 years (year 2010).

Complaints:

Protests must be submitted in writing to the Jury. A deposit of €50 is required. The protest deadline is 15 minutes after the official finish of the race. Protests must be submitted within this time limit at the Race Office or to a member of the Jury.

Data protection:

The participant agrees to the computerised processing and forwarding of his/her data to the organiser.

The personal data provided by participants when registering will be stored and processed for the purposes of organising and running the event. The data protection consent will be presented to the participants during registration and must be signed by them.

Media & press images/videos:

The photos, film footage and interviews of participants taken in connection with participation in the event may be distributed and published by the organiser on radio, television, social media (Facebook, Instagram, etc.), print media, books, photomechanical reproductions (films, video cassettes, etc.) without any claim to remuneration.
