EXTRACT FROM THE GENERAL
TARIFF CONDITIONS

- The ski pass is person-specific and non-transferable.
- Misuse of a ski pass or purchase entitlements will result in its withdrawal and exclusion from transport. A fine is issued for misuse. The attempt to transfer a ski pass to another guest is already considered to be misuse. Ski amadé and its member companies' entitlement to assert any claims for damages remains unaffected.
- Multi-day ski passes can be purchased and used from 3 pm of the previous day. Exception: Tauernseilbahn Haus/Ennstal.
- All ticket holders are responsible for keeping their ski pass safe so that third parties do not have access to it.
- Subsequent exchange or changing the validity period of a ski pass is not possible. No replacement in the event of loss, theft or forgotten tickets (data carriers).
- A separate evening ticket is required for floodlit toboggan runs and night skiing.
- A mountain rescue contribution must be made by the injured party for rescue and transport following an accident on the slopes, whereby the amount is determined by the respective member company.
- Please take note of the "General Tariff Conditions" and terms of carriage of the respective lifts (notice to be found at ticket offices and lifts).
- Safety notice: with the exception of the clearly marked and illuminated night pistes, all slopes are closed between 5 pm and 8 am (please observe the ski area-specific opening times). Slope preparation and snowmaking is carried out during these times. (Beware: cables are laid across the slopes)
- Ski touring is not permitted on our slopes at any time of day or night, with the exception of the designated touring trails.
- There are separate tariffs and conditions of carriage for piste walkers (with winter sports equipment) according to region and ski area-specific conditions.
- Subject to errors, price changes and misprints.

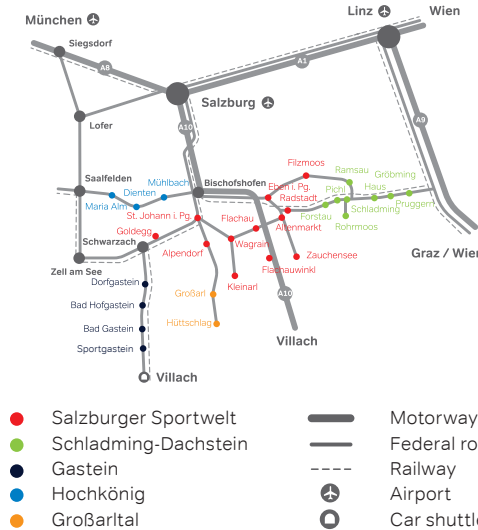
